Privacy Policy

Our Site, applications and forum might ask to use your personal data and information. Your personal data and information provided by you will be protected by the Company at all times during your use of the site, forum and applications and even when you stop using them since we believe strongly in fundamental privacy rights. Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with our privacy practices, accessible via the headings below, and contact us if you have any questions.

Definition of Personal Data and Information?

Personal data is information that is related to an identified or identifiable individual. Therefore, we treat any data that relates to an identified or identifiable individual or that is linked or linkable to them by our website and applications as “personal data”. This means that data that directly identifies you — such as your name — is personal data, and also data that does not directly identify you, but that can reasonably be used to identify you — such as the serial number of your device — is personal data. Aggregated data is considered non-personal data for the purposes of this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy covers how the company and its affiliated companies handle personal data whether you interact with us on our site, through our apps, or in person. Our Privacy Policy does not apply to how third parties define personal data or how they use it. We encourage you to read their privacy policies and know your privacy rights before interacting with them.

Privacy Rights

We respect your ability to know, access, correct, transfer, restrict the processing of, and delete your personal data. We do not sell or use your data in any way. We will be securing the protection of your Personal Data. Such data must be processed fairly for specified purposes and on the basis of your consent, or some other legitimate basis laid down by law. You will always have the right to access the collected data, and the right to have it rectified.

Data subjects have the following rights with regards to their personal information:

- The right to be informed about the collection and the use of their personal data
- The right to access personal data and supplementary information
- The right to have inaccurate personal data rectified, or completed if it is incomplete
- The right to erasure (to be forgotten) in certain circumstances
- The right to restrict processing in certain circumstances
- The right to data portability, which allows the data subject to obtain and reuse their personal data for their own purposes across different services
- The right to object to processing in certain circumstances
- The right to withdraw consent at any time (where relevant)

Use of Personal Data

We use personal data to power our services, to process your demands, to connect you with third parties as consented by you, to communicate with you, for security and fraud prevention, and to comply with law. We may also use personal data for other purposes with your consent.

We use your personal data only when we have a valid legal basis to do so. Depending on the circumstance, we may rely on your consent or the fact that the processing is necessary to fulfill a contract with you, protect your vital interests or those of other persons, or to comply with law. We may also process your personal data where we believe it is in our or others' legitimate interests, taking into consideration your interests, rights, and expectations.



We might share personal data with service providers who act on our behalf, our partners, or others at your direction. Further, we do not share personal data with third parties for their own marketing purposes.

To make sure your personal data is secure, we communicate our privacy and security guidelines to all our employees and strictly enforce privacy safeguards within the company.
